Additionally, Scott spearheaded the development of coverage enhancement solutions such as FirstNet MegaRange™ – a suite of High-Power User Equipment (HPUE), and portable assets, such as the Compact Rapid Deployable (CRD) and miniCRD – making FirstNet, Built with AT&T the first in the industry to enable agencies to own their own deployable solutions. These advancements have significantly enhanced connectivity and coverage for first responders, empowering them to perform their duties more effectively and safely, especially when lives are on the line.
