Dr. Tabak:

Pursuant to Rules X and XI of the U.S. House of Representatives, we write to follow-up on our request for information and documents from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) that could help support the Committee's potential legislative efforts to improve pandemic preparedness, strengthen the NIH grant oversight, and enhance the biosafety of laboratory and field research.

On May 3, 2023, we sent a letter requesting documents relating to any early SARS-CoV-2 sequences, data from early COVID-19 cases, or other pertinent documents related to the early phase of the pandemic the NIH may have or has had. Nearly three months later, we have no meaningful evidence that the NIH is responding to this request.

Given this lack of response and the lack of meaningful engagement with committee staff to provide a document production, we request that the NIH provide responsive documents by no later than August 31, 2023. In the event that the NIH does not provide documents by that date, the Committee will be forced to consider compulsory process to secure production of the requested documents.
