

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 1355
OFFERED BY M . _____

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Weatherization En-
3 hancement and Readiness Act of 2025”.

4 SEC. 2. WEATHERIZATION.

(a) AVERAGE COST PER DWELLING UNIT.—Section 415(c)(1) of the Energy Conservation and Production Act (42 U.S.C. 6865(c)(1)) is amended by striking “\$6,500” and inserting “\$12,000”.

(b) REAUTHORIZATION OF WEATHERIZATION AS-

SISTANCE PROGRAM.—Section 422 of the Energy Con-

servation and Production Act (42 U.S.C. 6872) is amend-

ed by striking paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting the

following:

14 “(1) \$300,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
15 through 2028;

16 “(2) \$325,000,000 for fiscal year 2029; and

17 “(3) \$350,000,000 for fiscal year 2030.”.

1 **SEC. 3. READINESS REPORT.**

2 Section 414D(i) of the Energy Conservation and Pro-
3 duction Act (42 U.S.C. 6864d(i)) is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “; and” and
5 inserting a semicolon;

6 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “achieved.”
7 and inserting “achieved; and”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(3) the impacts of enhancement and innova-
10 tion readiness efforts on eligibility for the weather-
11 ization program conducted under this part.”.
