A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Energy from finalizing, implementing, or enforcing the proposed rule titled “Energy Conservation Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Consumer Conventional Cooking Products”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Save Our Gas Stoves
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STANDARDS FOR KITCHEN RANGES AND OVENS.**

2 Section 325(h) of the Energy Policy and Conserva-
3 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 6295(h)) is amended by adding at
4 the end the following:

5 “(3) The Secretary may not determine that imposi-
6 tion of an energy conservation standard under this section
7 for kitchen ranges or ovens is economically justified for
8 purposes of subsection (o) unless the Secretary determines
9 that imposition of such energy conservation standard is
10 not likely to result in the unavailability in the United
11 States of a type (or class) of product based on what type
12 of fuel the product consumes.”.

13 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON RULEMAKING.**

14 The Secretary of Energy may not finalize, implement,
15 or enforce the proposed rule titled “Energy Conservation
16 Program: Energy Conservation Standards for Consumer
17 Conventional Cooking Products” (88 Fed. Reg. 6818
18 (February 1, 2023)) or any substantially similar rule.
