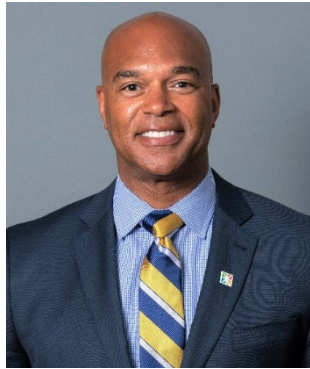




**Jamie Ulmer**  
President & Chief Executive Officer



Jamie L. Ulmer, MHA, MA, Major, U.S. Army (Retired), is Chief Executive Officer of Healthcare Network in Collier County, Florida. He oversees over \$125 million health system with nearly 600 employees, serving one of the fastest-growing regions in the country. Under his leadership, Healthcare Network has expanded access through new pharmacy sites and delivery services, OB telehealth for high-risk pregnancies, infusion therapy, women's health programs, and the first school-based health clinic in Southwest Florida. He has secured more than \$20 million in state appropriations and philanthropy to construct a new comprehensive health center in Golden Gate Estates, a medical desert, expected to serve 40,000 patients annually in its first year. He also established Family Medicine and Pediatric Dental residency programs to strengthen the healthcare workforce, introduced new addiction treatment and pediatric dental IV sedation programs, and expanded care through mobile health units.

Prior to joining Healthcare Network, Mr. Ulmer served as CEO of Heart of Florida Health Center in Marion County, Florida, where he led major organizational growth from \$8 million to \$70 million and spearheaded county jail healthcare contracts in Marion and Sumter Counties. He was previously recruited to serve as Chief Operating Officer of Rural Health Services, Inc., a Federally Qualified Health Center in Aiken, South Carolina. His public health experience also includes serving as the state's public health administrator for Emergency Medical Services for Children with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, and as Installation Public Health Administrator for the U.S. Army at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. A retired U.S. Army Medical Service Corps Officer with 24 years of service, his military career included multiple combat tours earning him leadership commendations and the Bronze Star Medal.

Mr. Ulmer holds a Master of Arts in Healthcare Administration and a Master of Arts in Human Resources Development, both from Webster University, and a Bachelor of Science in Psychology from South Carolina State University. He serves on the Foundation Board of Directors of Florida Gulf Coast University, and the Greater Naples Board of Chamber of Commerce. Jamie is an active Board Member of both the National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC) and the Florida Association of Community Health Centers (FACHC), helping to shape policy and strategy for community health centers at the state and national levels. He is married to the former Bethany Perry of Camden, SC. They have three daughters and two grandsons.
